In the reference cited, orders were issued for implementing a paperless system for the submission and processing of bills through the Integrated Financial Management and Information System (IFMIS) in the Secretariat Branch on a pilot basis. The Government is now extending the paperless system across the State.

Accordingly, the Government has decided to implement paperless submission and processing of bills through the IFMIS across the State. All Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) shall submit bills online only, along with scanned supporting documents duly authenticated using a valid digital signature in accordance with the Information Technology Act, 2000. Physical copies of bills shall no longer be submitted to the Treasuries, Pay and Accounts Offices (PAOs) and the Pay and Accounts Office (Twin Cities) with effect from 15.08.2026.
